WASTE DISPOSAL SITE INFORMATION BULLETIN

ATTENTION FRONT OF YONGE RESIDENTS **“NEW” WASTE DISPOSAL SITE HOURS EFFECTIVE** **MARCH 3rd, 2018**

November 1st to April 30th:

Tuesdays 12:30 pm to 4:30 pm - Saturdays 9:00 am to 4:00 pm

May 1st to October 31st:

**Tuesdays and Thursdays 12:00 pm to 5:00 pm -
Saturdays 9:00 am to 5:00 pm**

Accepted Garbage Bags: Only clear/tinted transparent bags will be accepted at the landfill site. This helps encourage recycling and helps extend the life of our landfill. Most retailers including Purcell's Freshmart, Superstore and Canadian Tire sell clear or tinted garbage tags.

Bagtags: Are available at the Township office or at Purcell's Freshmart at a cost of \$2.00 each.

Placement of Bagtags: Every bag of household waste should have a white bagtag affixed around the neck of a clear bag, as shown in the illustration on the face of the tag.

Waste Site Access Card Replacement: Every residence in the township has been issued a WDS access card. This card identifies you as a Front of Yonge resident, and is required for entry to the Waste Site. If you do not have a card because it was lost, or you recently moved here, please order a new card at the Township Office. All replacement cards are \$25.00.

Waste Site Gatehouse Attendant: The Commissionaires are required to check for WDS access cards, and for bagtags on household waste. Please show them these items each time you enter the site.

RECYCLING PROGRAM

Mixed Paper Bin

- Newspapers, flyers, inserts
- Magazines
- Catalogues
- Fine paper
- Paper egg cartons
- Books (soft/hard cover, telephone)
- Boxboard (including cereal & cracker boxes)
- Polycoated paper – milk and juice cartons, tetra packs, juice boxes (with screw tops removed) and clean paper plates



Corrugated Cardboard Bin

- Corrugated cardboard
-flattened and bundled

Plastic Bin

- Plastics #1 - #7 Includes plastic containers, plastic bottles, plastic tubs & jugs, clam shells, blister packs, salad boxes, boat and shrink wrap, plastic grocery bags, retail bags and outer plastic liners
(Please place all plastic bags inside one bag and tie-off)

Metal containers

- Aluminum and tin cans
- Aluminum pie plates, Foil

Scrap Metal Bin

- All ferrous and non-ferrous metals
- Propane cylinders with valve removed
- Metal coat hangers
- Empty clean/dry paint cans
- White goods: stoves, fridges, freezers – must be certified CFC/ Freon removed

Waste Electronics

- Household electronics including computers, monitors, TV sets, radios, keyboards, mice, modems, printers, telephones, cell phones and pagers, cameras, VCR's
(small appliances are NOT APPLICABLE)

Items Which are Not Recycled

- Gift wrap, tissue paper
- Cellophane and kitchen wrap
- Bubble wrap, Zip Lock style bags
- Plastic glasses, plates, cutlery
- CD cases, plastic toys
- Foil lined boxes or bags
- Cloth or clothing
- Agricultural wrap
- Lawn furniture, plastic bins, etc.
- Hazardous Waste
- Styrofoam
