BAGS TAGS

The price of **bags tags will be increasing to \$2 each, starting January 2, 2016**. A new style of bag tag will be available soon. The current blue tags will only be accepted at the waste disposal site until April 30, 2016. After this date, unused blue tags may be returned to the township office for a refund.

DOG TAGS

The 2016 dog tags are now available at the Township Office. The price per tag will remain the same as last year: **\$12.50 for all spayed/neutered dogs, \$20 for all non-spayed/non-neutered dogs, until the March 31st deadline**. After March 31st, the purchase price for tags will double.
