Approval of Agenda

Moved by Roger and seconded by Jeff that the agenda be approved. Carried

Approval of Minutes

Moved by Jeff and seconded by Roger that the minutes of the January 28, 2016 meeting be approved as circulated. Carried.

Unfinished Business:

a) Mallorytown Country Market: Elaine received an email with regrets from Laurie Barcier, as she is unable to attend this meeting. She has been successful in recruiting 14 vendors for the upcoming country market. Musical groups have been lined up for five of the Sundays so far. We had put \$500 in the budget, but have committed \$650 so far. The Heritage Committee will contribute \$250. It was felt that the CDC should have a table at the market for the first Sunday, and as many other Sundays as possible. The committee members will attend the following Sundays:

Richard will put out the MCM signs for each of the weekends.

b) Sign List: Richard reported that last year half of the signs were purchased, and the remainder are being installed now. Three more have been added to the list to order this year, including the cemetery, the park at the coach house, and Recreation Park. Richard suggested that we consider getting signs for the 401 exits in 2017.

c) Leeds and 1000 Islands Joint Event: There is a meeting tomorrow in Lansdowne. Shannon Morrison is now involved, and will organize a shorter family event in Rockport. Volunteers are needed from Front of Yonge: Jeff, Roger, and Gail have volunteered. Richard will ask three of the firefighters to attend to provide first aid and other assistance.

New Business

a) Kiosk: Richard has spoken with Bill about the need to re-install the paving stones which will be under the kiosk, as soon as possible. Elaine confirmed that the kiosk is to be moved back at least the width of the sign, to allow for better sight lines when leaving the parking lot.
