



## **SPECIAL NOTICE TO RESIDENTS**

At the March 16, 2020 regular meeting of Council, the decision was made to take the following steps to help us protect our community and staff from the risks related to the COVID-19 virus. Effective immediately and until further notice:

- The library, Mallory Coach House museum and Community Centre are closed.
- The Township Office will be open to staff ONLY. The public is asked to phone or email inquiries. Visits may be scheduled by appointment only.
- The Public Works department will operate as usual with the same limitations for the public at that building as the Township Office.
- Fire services will operate as usual. Inquiries of permits can be made at the Township Office by phone.
- The landfill site will operate as usual but we ask that patrons respect the social space of staff members.
- All meetings of Council's sub-committees are cancelled. Regular Council meetings will continue for now until decided otherwise.

Community events that were published in the March newsletter including Mallorytown Talks & the Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary pancake breakfast have been cancelled.

Today, March 17, 2020 we also heard that the Province of Ontario has declared a health emergency which places more restrictions on other public venues such as restaurants, all interior recreation centres, churches and entertainment facilities.
