Population Facts

In 2011 the population of Front of Yonge was 2,680, a decrease of 4.4% from 2,803 reported in the 2006 Census. The province of Ontario had a growth rate of 5.7% to 12,851,821 over the same period.

51.5% (1,380) of Front of Yonge's population is made up of people over the age of 45. Only 43.4% (5,570,620) of Ontario's population is over the age of 45. Therefore, the township has a higher concentration of people in the older pre and post retirement age groups.

Front of Yonge has a lower concentration of the age group between 15-30, in comparison to Ontario. The township has 380 people or 14.2% in this age group, while Ontario has 2,531,665 people or 19.7%.

The median age of the population is 46.0 in Front of Yonge compared to the median age of 40.4 in Ontario.

Income

Front of Yonge has a lower median family income than Ontario at \$75,568 and \$80,987 respectively. The average family income is also lower than Ontario at \$86,302 vs. \$100,152.

The median individual income for Front of Yonge is higher than Ontario at \$34,280 vs. \$30,526. However, the average individual income for the township is lower compared to Ontario at \$38,605 vs. \$42,264.

The average family size in Front of Yonge is 2.8 compared to 3.1 for Ontario.
