THE WASTE SITE WILL TEMPORARILY BE ACCEPTING ONE UNTAGGED BAG OF GARBAGE PER VEHICLE EACH WEEK. THIS WILL ALSO APPLY TO GARBAGE PICK-UP FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS. WASTE SITE ACCESS CARDS ARE STILL REQUIRED TO GAIN ENTRY INTO THE SITE.

REMINDER: PLEASE ENSURE CARDBOARD IS SEPARATED FROM BOXBOARD RECYCLING. THERE IS A DEDICATED BIN FOR CARDBOARD. BOXBOARD (E.G. CEREAL & CRACKER BOXES, ROLLS FROM PAPER TOWELS, ETC.) IS RECYCLED WITH PAPER.

TOTAL BURN BAN IN EFFECT



Due to the need for social distancing and to assist in the health & safety of firefighters during the COVID-19 pandemic, all municipalities within the United Counties of Leeds & Grenville have implemented a total burn ban, including campfires. **The fine for burning during a burn ban is \$615.**

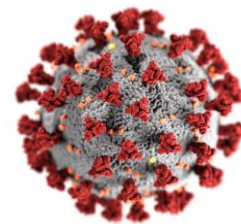
