### TRANSPORTATION OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

In April 2017 Front of Yonge Council passed a resolution asking the Ontario Ministry of Transportation and Federal Transport Canada to develop regulations that would take trucks carrying dangerous goods off the highways during extreme weather conditions. As we know a truck carrying a dangerous chemical overturned in March 2017 taking the life of the driver and injuring over 20 others as a result of inhaling the deadly fumes. Many of the injured were OPP, firefighters and paramedics. On September 18, 2017 Mayor Haley along with nine other Mayors from the region attended a meeting in Kingston with Transport Canada, MTO, OPP and the Ontario Fire Marshall's Office to pursue Council's April resolution. A meeting is being scheduled with the Minister.

## **FIRE PREVENTION WEEK - October 8-14, 2017**

This year's theme is "Every Second Counts: Plan 2 Ways Out!" Smoke and fire spread fast. There's no time to figure out how to escape AFTER a fire starts. That's why it is so important that everyone has working smoke alarms in their home and that they practice a home fire escape plan with everyone in their household BEFORE there's a fire.

## **72-HOUR EMERGENCY KITS**

It is always a good idea to have an emergency kit prepared at your home, at all times. Your kit should include, but not be limited to, the following items: bottles of water, canned food, manual can opener, flashlight and batteries, extra batteries, first aid kit, special needs items (eg. medications, list of allergies, etc.), canes, walker, hearing aids, breathing apparatus, identification, cash, emergency contact list.
