TEMPORARY WASTE SITE HOURS
WEDNESDAYS: 9 – 4 pm
SATURDAYS: 8 – 4 pm



TEMPORARILY, THE WASTE SITE IS STILL ACCEPTING ONE UNTAGGED BAG OF GARBAGE PER VEHICLE EACH WEEK. THIS WILL ALSO APPLY TO GARBAGE PICK-UP FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS. WASTE SITE ACCESS CARDS ARE STILL REQUIRED TO GAIN ENTRY INTO THE SITE.

REMINDER: PLEASE ENSURE CARDBOARD IS SEPARATED FROM BOXBOARD RECYCLING. THERE IS A DEDICATED BIN FOR CARDBOARD. BOXBOARD (E.G. CEREAL & CRACKER BOXES, ROLLS FROM PAPER TOWELS, ETC.) IS RECYCLED WITH PAPER.

REMINDER: SALVAGING OF ANY TYPE OF MATERIAL IS PROHIBITED

NEW WASTE SITE ACCESS CARDS

New access cards will be mailed with the final tax bills. Landlords must ensure their tenants receive a card. This card must be shown to gain entry into the site. After June 30th, current cards will no longer be accepted.

PROPERTY TAXES

The 2020 final tax bill will be mailed the first week of June. The first installment is due June 30th and the second installment is due September 30th. Reminder notices will NOT be sent out for the second installment.

DOG TAGS

Reminder: The fee for licenses will double on June 1st

Please mail a cheque or pay through online banking. Pricing until June 1st: \$12.50 for all spayed/neutered dogs, \$20 for all non-spayed/non-neutered dogs. Please send us your dog(s) information (name, age, colour, breed, gender, etc.) and we will mail your tag(s) to you.

UPCOMING 2020 ROADS PROJECTS

Marsh Road Rehabilitation: Starting mid-June and continuing over the next few years, Marsh Road will undergo major improvements, resulting in a resurfaced road. Approved in the 2020 budget is the first stage which includes the preparation and placement of gravel on 2 kilometers of the road, starting at County Rd 5.

Old River Road & Landing Road stone maintenance: Scheduled for mid-June.

Purvis Street Resurfacing: Section of road between Caintown Rd & Devil's Door Rd, to be completed later this summer (exact date to be determined by contractor).

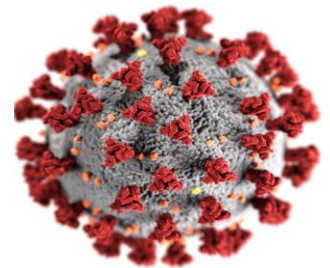


BROADBAND INTERNET
