2016 DOG TAGS

The 2016 dog tags are available at the Township Office. Tag prices remain the same as last year: \$12.50 for all spayed/neutered dogs, \$20 for all non-spayed/non-neutered dogs. The deadline to purchase tags is March 31st. Effective April 1st, the price per tag doubles. If you are unable to make it to the office during regular business hours, please mail a cheque, along with your dog's information (name, age, colour, breed, sex, etc.) and we will mail your tag(s) to you.

ATTENTION DOG OWNERS: It has come to our attention that there are some areas in the township where dog waste is an issue. Of particular concern, are the village sidewalks and private properties where people regularly walk their dogs. Any owner who does not pick up after their dog is in violation of Section 3 of the *Licensing, Regulating and Keeping of Dogs By-law #05-09*.

INTERIM TAX BILL

The 2016 Interim Tax bills were mailed out the first week in March, and are due March 31st. If you haven't received your bill please contact the Township Office. Tax bills can be paid through on-line banking, or at the township office by cheque, cash or debit. **Failure to receive a tax bill in the mail does not excuse the taxpayer from the responsibility of payment, nor does it relieve the liability of penalty for late payment.**
