2018 DOG TAGS

The 2018 dog tags are available at the Township Office. Tag prices remain the same as last year: \$12.50 for all spayed/neutered dogs, \$20 for all non-spayed/non-neutered dogs. The deadline to purchase tags is March 31st. Effective April 1st, the price per tag doubles. If you are unable to make it to the office during regular business hours, please mail a cheque, along with your dog's information (name, age, colour, breed, sex, etc.) and we will mail your tag(s) to you.

INTERIM TAX BILLS

The 2018 interim tax bills were mailed out the first week in March, and are due March 28th. If you haven't received your bill, please contact the Township Office. Tax bills can be paid through on-line banking, or at the township office by cheque, cash or debit. **Failure to receive a tax bill in the mail does not excuse the taxpayer from the responsibility of payment, nor does it relieve the liability of penalty for late payment.**

BURNING PERMITS

A reminder to residents and property owners: ALL burning requires a permit. Permits can be obtained at the Township Office during regular business hours. There is no cost for burning permits. Only campfires are permitted within the Village of Mallorytown. Please note: Tenants are not permitted to sign for burning permits – owners only.

FIRE DEPARTMENT LADIES AUXILIARY ANNUAL PANCAKE BREAKFAST

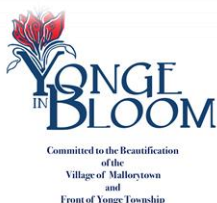
