### STYROFOAM RECYCLING SUSPENDED

Due to lower oil prices, the market for recycled Styrofoam is disappearing, as it has become less expensive to produce new material. Therefore, the Township is forced to suspend the recycling program for this product **effective immediately**. Clean, hard, Styrofoam material in clear bags will only be accepted free of charge until July 8, 2016. After that date, it must be included with household waste, and tagged.

When purchasing items packaged in Styrofoam, always confirm with the retail store that any packaging can be left at the store, or sent back with the delivery truck. If you would support legislation to reduce or eliminate Styrofoam packaging, we encourage you to contact your MPP, Steve Clark, at [infosteveclarkmpp.com](http://infosteveclarkmpp.com). The Township will be petitioning the Province to take action in regards to this issue.

### FINAL TAX BILLS

The first installment of the final 2016 tax bill is due June 30<sup>th</sup>. The second installment of the final 2016 tax bill is due September 30<sup>th</sup>. Reminder notices will **NOT** be sent out for the second installment. **Failure to receive a tax bill in the mail does not excuse the taxpayer from the responsibility of payment, nor does it relieve the liability of penalty for late payment.** When using online or telephone banking, it's important to make payments at least 3 business days prior to the tax due date in order to meet payment deadlines.

### BUILDING DEPARTMENT REMINDERS

The Township Chief Building Official, Ernest Tkachuk, is employed on an as-needed basis on Tuesday and Thursday mornings. If you would like to arrange an inspection or meet with him, please contact the Township Office prior to those days.

All swimming pools require building permits, including inflatable pools. In-ground swimming pools require fences and above-ground pools that have walls shorter than 48 inches also require fencing. A copy of the swimming pool by-law is available at the Township Office or on their website, [www.Mallorytown.ca](http://www.Mallorytown.ca).

Any structure which is 108 sq.ft. or more, requires a building permit. **NOTE:** This includes sheds, decks, lean-tos and shipping containers.

### RECREATION PARK IMPROVEMENTS

This spring, the Township received a grant from Healthy Kids Community Challenge. This has provided the Township the opportunity to make several upgrades to the Recreation Park, including the dugouts/washrooms. Equipment and supplies for minor ball were also purchased.
