Marvin will relay traffic count speed information for Graham Lake Road and Caintown Road to the OPP. A light at the Caintown sand shed needs to be repaired and a garbage can will be installed at the car pool lot.

Further research on a vehicle that will suit the needs at the Township waste site will be done in the coming weeks.

Marvin has been asked to install the chevron at the end of Purvis Street and Caintown Road.
