PUBLIC WORKS SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

The Public Works Superintendent went over his report with Council. Discussion took place regarding paving of the Fire Hall parking lot. The work was partially completed last year and the remainder of the project is included in this year's budget. Staff have requested an additional corner section of the parking lot be paved to complete the parking lot in its entirety. Council agreed to proceed with the additional work. Formal quotes from Tackaberry Construction have been filed.

Discussion took place regarding wait times at the waste disposal site. Due to social distancing, the number of vehicles permitted at the landfill area at one time is limited. This has resulted in increased wait times for patrons and traffic safety concerns. Council agreed to temporarily open the site one hour earlier for each day of operation in an effort to reduce traffic congestion. Council also discussed and agreed to increase the number of vehicles on the hill to 6, as a way to alleviate the traffic back-up at the gatehouse. Those vehicles with brush will not be counted with the ones on the hill.

Reconfiguration of the waste site is continuing. The test well will be constructed on May 12th.
